## Subject:

Authorization to issue and administer three Contract Agreements under the Bay Trail Grant Program with East Bay Regional Park District in an amount of \$200,000; City of San Rafael in an amount of \$240,000, and Solano Transportation Authority in an amount of \$400,000, with funds received from the State Coastal Conservancy's Bay Trail Block Grant #6 funds for a total contracted amount of \$840,000

# Background:

On November 21, 2019, the Association of Bay Area Governments (ABAG) Governing Board approved Resolution 15-19 (attached) authorizing staff to receive and administer \$1,400,000 from the State Coastal Conservancy (Conservancy) known as Bay Trail Block Grant #6 to be utilized to complete design and implementation of various segments of the Bay Trail throughout the nine county San Francisco Bay Area.

The Conservancy funds provide capital support to advance completion of the Bay Trail and continue implementation of the San Francisco Bay Trail Plan. As part of the Bay Trail Grant Program, staff is requesting authorization from the ABAG Executive Board to issue and administer three contract agreements totaling **\$840,000** from the Bay Trail Block Grant #6 funds. The three contract agreements would be for the following organizations, projects, and amounts:

- East Bay Regional Park District, Martinez Bay Trail Phase II Project, \$200,000
- City of San Rafael, Bay Trail Extension on Grand Avenue Project, \$240,000
- Solano Transportation Authority, Bay Trail Vine/Trail Gap Closure Project, \$400,000
