## **ABAG Local Government Services**

- Bay Area Housing Finance Authority (BAHFA)
- ABAG Finance Authority (ACFA)

# **Advancing CA Financing Authority**

Since 1978, ACFA provided \$8 billion in tax-exempt financing to help meet needs of public agencies and their nonprofit partners

- Financings constructed/preserved/refinanced
  - 12,000 units of housing
  - Schools
  - Hospitals and clinics
  - Water Districts
  - Municipal Infrastructure
  - Museums
  - CFDs



## San Francisco Estuary Partnership

- Established under Clean Water Act's National Estuary Program (1988), as one of 28 estuaries of national significance
- Manages multi-benefit projects that improve the Estuary health by leveraging federal funds in state and local funds for regional-scale restoration, water quality improvement and resilience-building projects
- Staffs SF Bay Restoration Authority along with CA Coastal Conservancy, helping distribute \$25M/yr (Measure AA) in projects that restore the Bay and protect it from SLR




## **ABAG POWER and Initiatives**

- Provided, since 1989, cost savings and price stability for 38 members purchasing natural gas for public buildings
- Use of natural gas for municipal buildings identified as significant contributor to greenhouse gas emissions
- Adopted a Strategic Implementation Roadmap in 2021, encouraging:
  - Default product bundled with offsets
  - Transparent and socially responsible gas
  - Voluntary electrification incentives
  - SB 1383 compliance



## **BayREN History and Structure**

- Formed in 2012 by Bay Area cities/counties to better collaborate on energy efficiency
- Now one of four Regional Energy Networks in California
- Directed to:
  - Serve Hard-to-Reach
  - Fill gaps in market
  - Support innovative, scalable pilot programs

# **Bay Area Multifamily Building Enhancements** (BAMBE)

#### Eligibility

 Multifamily properties with five or more dwelling units, located in 9-county Bay Area with focus on deed restricted and NOAH


#### Program offerings

No-Cost Energy Consulting

Energy usage analysis, site visits, scope development


#### Cash Rebates

Flat rate \$750/unit, additional incentives for gas-toelectric conversions




## **Water Bill Savings Program**

- Allows water utilities to install improvements
- Being field tested in Windsor and Hayward
- No up-front payment, credit checks, or liens
- Monthly surcharge lower than savings
- Pay only while a customer at that location



# Regional Accomplishments and Impact



- 9 Counties, 101 Cities
- 6 Programs focused on
  - Energy efficiency upgrades
  - Electrification upgrades
  - Water energy nexus
  - Raising awareness among real estate and contractor industry
  - Energy code compliance










## **Example: Retrofit of Tenderloin SRO**

## Working with BAHFA to Add Value

- A major challenge facing homeowners, apartment owners and affordable housing operators is rapidly escalating utility costs
- BayREN's programs reduce electric and water usage by 15% to 24%, freeing up funds for renovation budgets, rent reductions and other family needs
- In launching BAHFA's Preservation, Anti-Displacement and Homeless Prevention Pilots, BayREN programs are increasing energy efficiency, reducing operating costs and lowering GHG
