Purpose of Project:	Implement a regional monitoring program for tidal wetlands in the San Francisco Estuary.
Brief Scope of Work:	Build on current work to advance program management and outreach, continue efforts on regulatory alignment, implement an equity and engagement strategy, and advance new indicators focused on people and wetlands.
Project Cost Not to Exceed:	\$5,000,000
Funding Source:	U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's San Francisco Bay Program Office
Fiscal Impact:	Funds programmed into FY 2024-25
Motion by Committee:	The Executive Board is requested to authorize the Executive Director of the Metropolitan Transportation Commission, or his designee, to enter into a funding agreement with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency on behalf of the Association of Bay Area Governments and the San Francisco Estuary Partnership in an amount of \$5,000,000 to implement the development of the Wetlands Regional Monitoring Program.
