

## Plan Bay Area 2050+/Transit 2050+: Round 2 Engagement

### Potential Pop-up Workshops

Staff is planning 18 pop-up workshops across the nine Bay Area counties. Below is a preliminary list of potential locations for summer 2024 public engagement. The locations below aim to expand the geographic reach of Round 1 engagement pop-ups, as well as facilitate outreach to Equity Priority Communities and transit riders.

The locations will be finalized in mid-July, pending review and input from the Policy Advisory Council, the Transit 2050+ project management team, the ABAG Administrative Committee, and the MTC Planning Committee.
