	California Transportation Commission Update
Subject:	Update on the May 2017 California Transportation Commission Meeting.
Background:	The California Transportation Commission (CTC) is responsible for programming and allocating certain state funds for the construction of highway, passenger rail, non-motorized facilities, and transit improvements throughout California. The CTC consists of eleven voting members and two non-voting ex-officio members. The San Francisco Bay Area has three (3) CTC members residing in its geographic area: Bob Alvarado, Jim Ghielmetti, and Carl Guardino.
	<u>May CTC Meeting (May 17, San Diego, California)</u> The CTC is scheduled to discuss the following issues of significance to the region. Note that the meeting date is after the MTC Programming and Allocations Committee meeting; any important updates will be presented at the June Committee meeting.
	Adoption of California Freight Investment Program Guidelines CTC will approve the guidelines for the California Freight Investment Program, which is set to receive about \$580 million in federal National Highway Freight Program formula funds over the next four years. Upon adoption of the guidelines, CTC will release a call for projects, due in late July. CTC plans to adopt the program in October. MTC staff will work with our Northern California partners to develop guidelines for committee consideration in June, and work with CMAs to approve project nominations at the July MTC meetings. 	Adoption of 2018 STIP Fund Estimate Assumptions Caltrans will present the final assumptions in developing the 2018 State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) Fund Estimate. The 2018 STIP Fund Estimate and Guidelines will be adopted in August. With the passage of the state transportation funding package in April, MTC staff expects over \$160 million be available for programming in the Bay Area. This contrasts with the \$115 million in Bay Area projects deleted from the 2016 STIP. Caltrans will release official draft figures in June.
