**Subject:** Quarterly report of the Executive Director's Delegated Authority actions

**Background:** MTC Resolution No. 3620, Revised, adopted by the Commission in

March 2004, allows the Executive Director to make administrative allocations of certain funds up to \$1 million, with authority to take any rescission actions requested by claimants. To keep the Commission informed on actions approved by the Executive Director, staff reports quarterly on all 'delegated authority' allocations or rescissions.

This is the second quarter report for FY2018-19, and covers the period from October 2018 through December 2018. The Executive Director approved the following allocation and rescission actions as summarized below and detailed in Attachment A:
