Motion by Committee:	The Executive Board is requested to authorize the Executive Director of the Metropolitan Transportation Commission, or her designee, to negotiate and enter into a contract on behalf of the San Francisco Estuary Partnership with Ariel Rubissow Okamoto for Writing, Editorial, and Administrative Services in an amount up to \$500,000 from on or about April 1, 2019 to June 30, 2023, with funding for the agreement consisting of three components: 1) EPA Grant Funds; 2) fundraising efforts by the contractor to be recommended; and 3) additional grant funds if available.
