<b>Purpose of Project:</b>	Promote and implement green infrastructure throughout the Bay Area to improve stormwater quality which impacts the health of San Francisco Bay
<b>Brief Scope of Work:</b>	Green stormwater infrastructure retrofits at 4 <sup>th</sup> & Fremont Streets and South Delaware Street at 9 <sup>th</sup> and East 5 <sup>th</sup> Avenues, San Mateo
<b>Project Cost Not To Exceed:</b>	\$400,000
<b>Funding Source:</b>	U.S. Environmental Protection Agency
<b>Fiscal Impact:</b>	Funds programmed in FY 2018-19 and 2019-20 Budgets
<b>Motion by Committee:</b>	The Executive Board is requested to authorize the Executive Director of the Metropolitan Transportation Commission, or her designee, to increase the existing ABAG subaward to the City of San Mateo for the Urban Greening Bay Area project to cover additional sites at a cost up to \$400,000 through December 31, 2019, and to decrease the existing subaward to the City of Sunnyvale to \$50,000 for green infrastructure planning through December 31, 2019.
