Subject:	Position on SB 50 (Wiener): Equitable Communities Incentives – Upzoning Near Transit & Jobs-Rich Areas and By Right Allowance for Small Residential Projects in Specified Areas
Background:	On May 10, the ABAG Legislation Committee recommended a "support if amended" position on SB 50 with the following requested amendments:
	 Ensure that the definition of jobs-rich areas identify areas that have a higher-than-average concentrations of jobs and accurately identifies areas that would result in shorter commutes;
	2) Allow for a density measure for transit-rich projects within ½-mile of rail or ferry stations to provide more flexibility than the bill's minimum height allowances, but provides the same development capacity (i.e. units) within the general station area; and
	 Provide more flexibility related to local parking requirements within ½-mile radius of a major transit stop based on local conditions.
Recommended Action:	The ABAG Executive Board is requested to adopt a "support if amended" position on SB 50.
