| Background:                              | On May 10, the ABAG Legislation Committee reviewed legislation<br>and recommended a "support and seek amendment" position on<br>AB 68 with the following requested amendment:   |
|  | <ul> <li>Ensure that local jurisdictions may require sprinklers for an<br/>accessory dwelling unit (ADU) if they are required for the<br/>primary residence.</li> </ul>   |
| Issues:                                  | The Legislation Committee requested that staff pursue an<br>amendment to ensure that a local jurisdiction may require a<br>residential sprinkler system in an ADU if a sprinkler system is<br>required for the existing house. Staff has confirmed that this bill<br>does not modify current law with regard to sprinkler requirements,<br>which specifically prohibits a mandate to add sprinklers if they are<br>not required for the existing residence, but also requires, pursuant<br>to the state's building code, sprinklers in an ADU if existing house<br>has a sprinkler system and requires sprinkler systems in all new<br>homes, including those built with an ADU. With this clarification,<br>staff recommends the Executive Board consider removing the<br>proposed amendment and adopt a "Support" position. |
| Recommended Action:                      | The ABAG Executive Board is requested to adopt a "support" position on AB 68.   |
