Change Order – Caltrain Clipper® Ticket Vending Machine (TVM) Retrofit: Cubic Transportation Systems, Inc. (Cubic) (\$57,000)

Subject: Cubic Change Order – Procure 32 Clipper Tri-Reader 3s for use by

Caltrain: (\$57,000)

Background: Caltrain would like to update its TVMs to support Clipper integration,

including vending Clipper cash value, products and cards. Currently, Caltrain's 65,000 daily riders (73% of whom use Clipper) have only three stations at which to load value to their Clipper cards, and no in-station

locations that allow a rider to get a Clipper card.

With this Change Order, Cubic will procure 32 Tri-Reader 3s for use in 12 Caltrain TVMs and will also assist the TVM vendor with testing on the Tri-Readers once installed. The 12 upgraded TVMs will be located at Caltrain's high-volume stations. Caltrain plans to upgrade additional

TVMs in subsequent phases.

This work will be funded by a Funding Agreement between Caltrain and

MTC.

Cubic is neither a disadvantaged business enterprise nor a small business

enterprise.

Issues: No issues identified.

Recommendation: Staff recommends that the Operations Committee authorize the Executive

Director or designee to negotiate and enter into a contract change order with Cubic, in an amount not to exceed \$57,000 to procure and test 32 Tri-

Reader 3s for use in Caltrain TVMs.
