Subject:	Contract Amendment – Regional Bus-on-Shoulder Assessment and Implementation Plan: Kittelson & Associates, Inc. (\$330,000)			
<b>Background:</b>	In order to address growing congestion on the Bay Area's regional highway network, MTC recognizes the need to implement near-term transportation solutions that focus on increasing person throughput via alternative modes of transportation, such as bus transit. One of the major challenges to encouraging mode shift, however, is the lack of travel time reliability for transit routes that operate on congested freeway corridors. Bus-on-Shoulder (BOS) operations offer a cost-effective strategy that can help improve transit travel times, on-time performance, and service reliability by reducing the impact of recurring and non-recurring congestion on transit operations.			
	Staff proposes to pursue the region's first BOS assessment to determine which regional highways are most suited for BOS operations and to identify opportunities for near-term implementation. More specifically, the assessment will identify potential highways and/or major arterial corridors for BOS operations, develop high-level operating parameters, assess safety impacts, prioritize potential locations, conduct additional traffic and geometric analyses, and develop an implementation plan. Staff will also coordinate with our partner agencies as part of the assessment.			
	On April 29, 2019, MTC issued a Request for Proposal (RFP) to pre- qualified firms from the On-Call Transportation Engineering and Planning Services Bench under Service Category A: Freeway Active Traffic Management and Service Category B: Travel Demand Management. MTC received proposals from two firms: Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. and Kittelson & Associates, Inc. A panel of MTC staff reviewed the proposals and evaluated them based on each firm's qualifications, understanding of the project, proposed work plan to complete the work, and written communication, in descending order of importance. Based upon this evaluation, staff recommends the selection of Kittelson &			

g upon this evaluation, staff recommends the selection of Kittelson & Associates, Inc. The Kittelson & Associates team demonstrated superior understanding of the project and provided a detailed work plan to complete the project. The team is also better qualified with both local and national experts in bus-on-shoulder planning and operations, and have completed similar and relevant studies recently.
