San Francisco Bay Area Water Trail Project

Subject: Adoption of Resolution No. 01-2020 Authorization to receive \$185,000 in funds from the California State Coastal Conservancy to support the San Francisco Bay Area Water Trail Project

Background: The California State Coastal Conservancy authorized the disbursement of an amount not to exceed one hundred and eighty five thousand dollars (\$185,000) to the Association of Bay Area Governments to develop and implement various projects for the Water Trail, directly or through subgrants, throughout the nine San Francisco Bay Area counties.

On March 21, 2013, the ABAG Executive Board adopted Resolution No. 02-13 encouraging all shoreline jurisdictions to adopt local resolutions of support and integrate Water Trail strategies into local plans to realize the vision of the Water Trail.

California State Coastal Conservancy funds provide for program management and capital support to continue implementation of the Enhanced San Francisco Bay Area Water Trail Plan. The Association of Bay Area Governments has been providing program operations support since 2011.

Recommended Action: The Executive Board is requested to adopt Resolution No. 01-20 authorizing the Executive Director of the Metropolitan Transportation Commission, or her designee, on behalf of the Association of Bay Area Governments and the San Francisco Bay Area Water Trail, to receive \$185,000 in funds from the California State Coastal Conservancy to support the San Francisco Bay Area Water Trail Project to develop and implement various projects for the Water Trail, directly or through subgrants, throughout the nine San Francisco Bay Area counties.
