**July 2019** Staff presents update on state legislation and budget trailer bill providing new opportunities for housing funding and housing supportive transportation investments

October 2019

Commission approves guidelines for the \$5 million Sub-HIP set-aside from the HIP program

## Highlight: MTC's Existing Housing Linkages

A quick reminder of two existing transportation programs with strongest ties to housing

#### **OBAG County Program**

- Distributed to counties based, in part, on housing performance
  - RHNA
  - · Building permits
  - Affordability
- Focused within PDAs (50%-70% targets)
- \$77M/year Federal STP/CMAQ





In addition to the other linkages to housing noted here, **both** programs also require compliance with state housing laws

#### Housing Incentive Pool (HIP)

#### HIP Race to the Top

- Distributed to top 15 cities with highest production of affordable housing units
- Based on units produced 2018 through 2022
- Units must be in PDAs/TPAs & meet other requirements (deed-restriction, affordability)
- \$71M total Federal STP/CMAQ

#### North Bay Sub-HIP

- Distributed to transportation projects in PDAs/TPAs that support affordable housing, recommended by CTAs
- \$5M total Federal STP/CMAQ

## Prior Evaluation of Additional Transportation Funds to Condition

Per Commission direction during 2018 RTIP discussions, staff conducted a comprehensive review of transportation fund sources

- Goal: Identify additional opportunities to connect transportation revenues to housing outcomes
- Approach: Suitability for conditioning funds based on housing performance depends on three main factors

#### Focus on fund sources that:

- 1. Are large enough to matter
- 2. MTC has discretion over
- 3. Are directed to cities and counties

## Outcome: Proposed Conditioning Approaches

In addition to identifying the proposed short list of transportation funds, staff proposed a few possible approaches to fund conditioning for consideration



- 1. Compliance Eligibility must be in compliance with state housing laws to receive funds
  - Existing Example OBAG County Program, HIP
  - Potential Refinement/Expansion expand the number of laws based on recent legislation; apply to other fund sources



- 2. Performance Incentive funding amounts based, all or in part, on housing performance relative to other jurisdictions and/or goals
  - Existing Example OBAG 2 County Program distribution formula, HIP Race to the Top
  - Potential Refinement/Expansion increase share of formula distributed on housing performance; strengthen connection between performance and funding (ex. weighting/points); apply to other fund sources



- 3. Performance Threshold must meet specific performance thresholds to receive funds
  - Existing Example none
  - Potential Refinement/Expansion establish threshold requirements (ex. RHNA progress);
     exclude strong market + weak performance jurisdictions (ex. bubble chart)


### What We Heard: Proposed Short List & Options

Staff compiled the following feedback at the 2018 Commission Workshop

- Focus on OBAG County Program, refine approach for OBAG 3
  - Evaluate existing OBAG program effectiveness
  - Mixed feedback on changing formula for OBAG 3 to favor housing production
  - Consider larger funding envelope/relationship to OBAG Regional Programs
- Concern about conditioning RTIP, SB1, RM3
- Some support for conditioning Bike-Ped funds to local jurisdictions
- Generally supportive of technical assistance for local agencies to encourage housing
- Generally supportive of updating the TOD policy should be reflective of the regional growth framework
- Include "Missing Middle" relates to Sub-HIP and PDA Connected Communities
