#### **MTC Financial Statements for December 2019**

**Subject:** MTC Financial Statements for the six-month period ending December 31, 2019.

MTC's financial statements as of December 31, 2019 include the following major highlights:

- (1) <u>Operating Balance:</u> For the six-month period ending December 31, 2019, we have collected \$33 million of revenue, recorded expenditures of \$21.2 million and have encumbered \$18.5 million of contracts.
- **(2)** <u>Operating Income</u>: State Funding, Local Funding Revenues and Transfers from other funds are below budget which is mainly due to the following:

#### **State Funding Revenue:**

California State Transportation Agency (CalSTA) – The \$4.7 million remaining balance under this grant is currently fully encumbered and since this grant will be expiring on June 30, 2021, it is anticipated that the remaining balance will be expended prior to the expiration date.

#### **Local Funding Revenue:**

**Transportation Fund for Clean Air (TFCA)** - The funding agreement for TFCA does not get executed until the later part of the year.

**Pavement Management -** Revenues are part of the annual license fee and technical service plan on pavement management. The technical service plan is paid in one lump sum upon completion of work.

**Miscellaneous Revenues** - \$1.9 million of the budget is for revenues from cities which is used as a local match for our federal Surface Transportation Block Grants (STBG) and Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) grants. The timing of grant funding reimbursement is based on STBG and CMAQ grant expenditures.

#### **Transfers from Other Funds:**

**BATA 1%** - Year-to-date transfers agree with actuals because the 1% Bay Area Toll Authority (BATA) administration fee was transferred at the beginning of the year.

Transfers in STA - Occur on a reimbursement basis.

**Membership Dues** – The Association of Bay Area Governments (ABAG) membership dues surcharge transfer of \$530,000 will occur during the fiscal year when all dues are collected. Based on the timing of grant funded projects it is not unusual for revenues to be lower than projected.

- (3) Operating Expenditures: Contract expenses including encumbrances are \$22.9 million (56%). Contract services are ahead of budget since this includes consultant contracts and license renewals that run over multiple years. The timing of contract expenditures is more closely tied to project work which may trend over multiple fiscal years instead of a single fiscal year.
- **(4)** <u>Federal Grants:</u> During the 2019-20 fiscal year we will be applying for eleven new grants and amending for the following STBG, CMAQ and State grants as follows:
  - Seven STBG totaling \$22.2 million;
  - Five new CMAQ improvement grants totaling \$45.2 million; and
  - Five new State Grants totaling \$6 million.

The combined \$238.9 million in active grants were expended as follows:

- \$4.5 million were spent on staff costs.
- \$74 million were expended and encumbered on various consultants that are detailed on pages 17 through 20 under Grant Funded Consultants.
- There was one grant that was fully spent and will be closed out during the FY 2019-20.

The remaining balance is currently \$159.8 million.

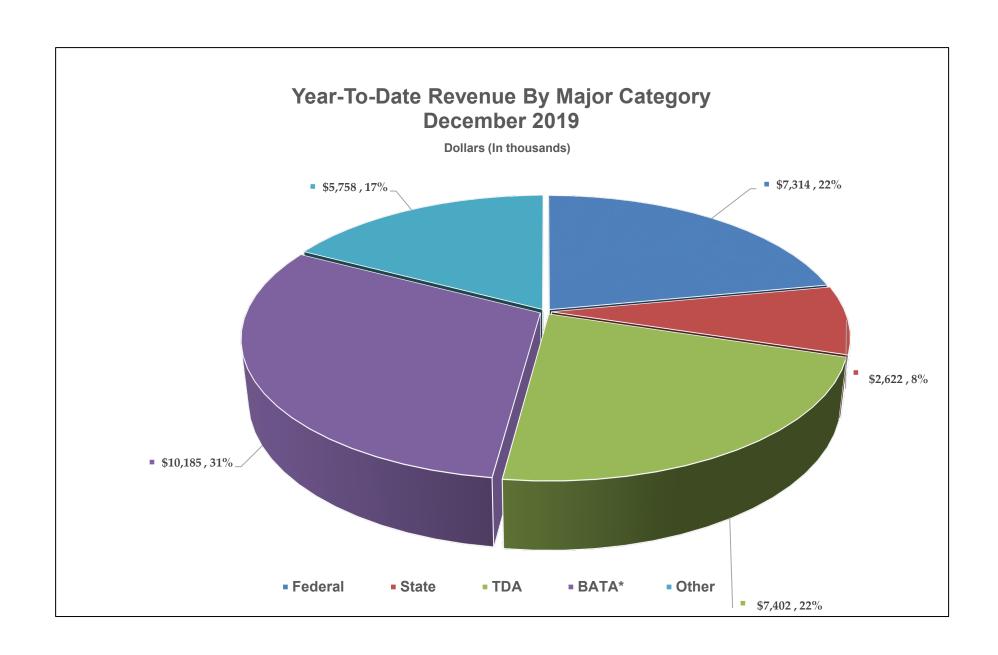

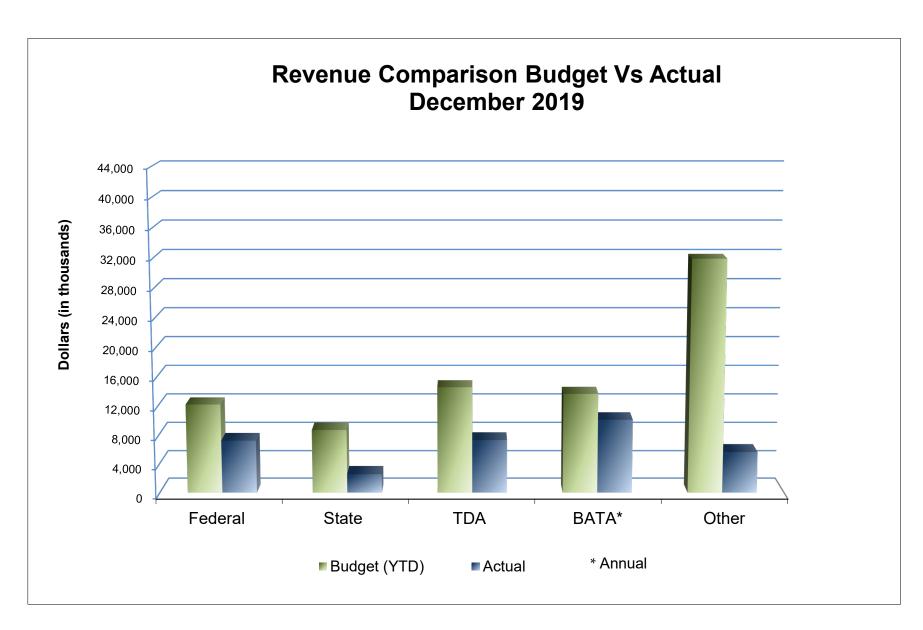

#### OPERATING INCOME MTC OPERATING BUDGET FOR FY 2019-20 As of December 2019 (50% of year)

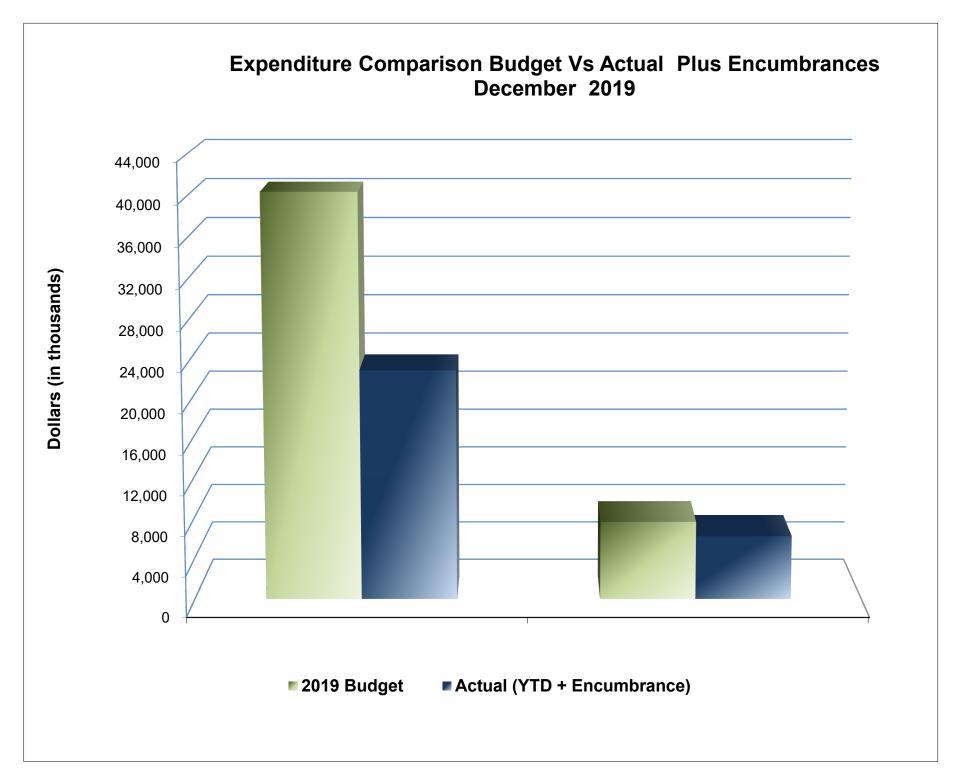

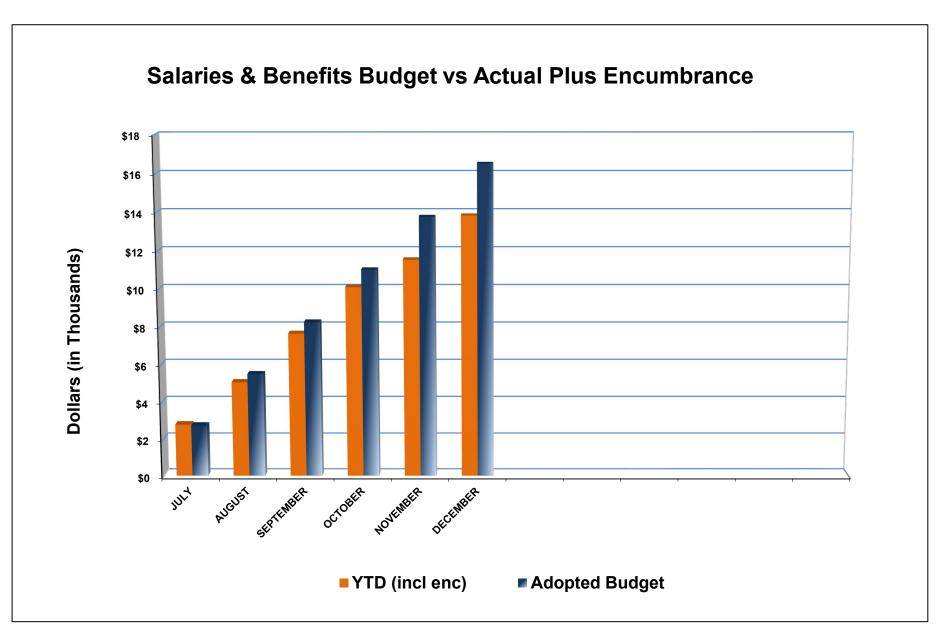
