Regional Housing Needs Allocation (RHNA) Update

Subject: Update on Regional Housing Needs Allocation (RHNA)

Background: RHNA is the state-mandated process to identify the number of

housing units (by affordability level) that each jurisdiction must accommodate in the Housing Element of its General Plan. For the last three RHNA cycles, ABAG has convened an ad hoc Housing

Methodology Committee (HMC) to advise staff on the

methodology for allocating a share of the region's total housing need to every local government in the Bay Area. The HMC includes local elected officials and staff as well as regional stakeholders to facilitate sharing of diverse viewpoints across

multiple sectors.

Issues: Update on RHNA and Housing Methodology Committee

Discussions

Staff will summarize work done by the Housing Methodology Committee. The Housing Methodology Committee has been meeting monthly since October 2019. Agenda packets for the

September 4, 2020.

Next Steps: The HMC will finalize its recommendations about the proposed

RHNA methodology at its final meeting on September 18 for consideration by the ABAG Regional Planning Committee in October. The ABAG Executive Board will consider the recommended proposed methodology in October; staff will request that the Board approve its release for public comment.
