Subject:	A proposed 20-year extension of the Sonoma County Transportation Authority's (SCTA) sales tax.		
Background:	Earlier this summer, the SCTA board of directors voted to ask Sonoma County voter to approve a 20-year extension of its existing 1/4-cent sales tax that will expire in 2025. The measure will appear as Measure DD on the November ballot. An early renewal would provide the certainty needed for SCTA to keep the project pipeline moving and provide matching funds for state transportation programs and other grar funds. The Measure DD tax renewal would sunset March 31, 2045. As a special tax, Measure DD would require two-thirds voter approval.
