	 Assembly Bill 43 (Friedman): Vision Zero-Setting Speed Limits to Enhance Roadway Safety
	 AB 43 permits cities to lower speed limits below the 85th percentile on streets with high injuries and fatalities. The bill also provides for greater flexibility to set speed limits in school zones and requires traffic surveyors take into account the presence of vulnerable groups, including children, seniors, the unhoused and persons with disabilities when setting speed limits.
