

### Role Designation and Strategy Assessment Revisions

- Based on feedback from policymakers in February, as well as ongoing discussions amongst staff and stakeholders, a handful of revisions were made to the implementation role designations and strategy assessments, including:
  - T1: Restore, Operate, and Maintain the Existing System changed from Partner to <u>Lead</u>
  - EC4: Allow Greater Commercial Densities in Growth Geographies changed from Support to Partner
- In addition to the symbol to designate strategies that have a high impact in achieving the Plan's GHG emissions reduction target, a symbol has also been added to designate strategies subject to California Air Resources Board (CARB) implementation review

# **Key Cross-Cutting Implementation Actions**

### Advocacy or Legislation

- Seek new revenues to support identified needs, from a next-generation transit network to a suite of sea level rise protections to affordable housing production & preservation
- Pursue advocacy goals and objectives identified in the adopted 2021 Final Advocacy Program that align with adopted Plan Bay Area 2050 strategies

### New, Existing, or Restructured Initiatives

• Continue and seek greater strategic alignment of a broad range of existing MTC/ABAG programs that support Plan vision and goals, from FasTrak START and Clipper START to Regional Housing Technical Assistance

### Planning or Research

• Continue evaluation of needs related to inclusive post-COVID recovery, from essential workers' mobility needs to support for struggling small businesses

# Transportation: Key Implementation Actions



### New, Existing, or Restructured Initiatives

- Implement the recommendations of the Blue Ribbon Transit Recovery Task Force and the Fare Integration Task Force
- Complete and implement the TOD Policy Update to ensure land use supports transit investments and supports access to transit

### Planning or Research

- Identify strategies to advance roadway pricing with complementary strategies through deep public engagement —
- Complete and implement the recommendations of the Regional Active Transportation Plan

# Housing: Key Implementation Actions



#### New, Existing, or Restructured Initiatives

- Provide financial resources and technical assistance through the Regional Housing Technical Assistance Program and PDA Planning Program —
- Launch and deliver a suite of housing pilot projects to assist local jurisdictions

#### Planning or Research

- Complete and implement the Expanded Regional Housing Portfolio Business Plan
- Partner with local jurisdictions to study and accelerate redevelopment of aging malls and office parks and explore approaches to catalyze utilization of public- and community-owned land





# Economy: Key Implementation Actions




### New, Existing, or Restructured Initiatives

 Complete the TOD Policy Update and incorporate expanded jobs emphasis within the PDA Planning Program 🗣 🗀

### Planning or Research

- Evaluate funding sources and develop a pilot Priority Production Area (PPA) Planning and Technical Assistance Program, with a goal of supporting up to five PPAs by 2025
- Partner with economic stakeholders to conduct regional economic studies & best practices related to closing the "digital divide"





### **Environment: Key Implementation Actions**



### Advocacy or Legislation

- Explore potential legislative reforms to establish clear roles for sea level rise adaptation planning, funding, and implementation
- Seek legislative authority to expand existing Bay Area Commuter Benefits Program in partnership with BAAQMD •

### New, Existing, or Restructured Initiatives

- Restructure MTC Climate Initiatives program and operational TDM programs to ensure they can effectively scale over the next five years -
- Evaluate the feasibility of expanding the scope/mission of BayREN to develop a broader range of program offerings that will support building retrofits and water/energy upgrades
