| Background: | The San Francisco Estuary Partnership's (SFEP) Clean Vessel Act (CVA) Program focuses on preventing sewage pollution to waterways through work at marinas, direct boater education, and enhancing the sewage pumpout network within the 11-county San Francisco Bay-Delta region plus Monterey and Santa Cruz counties. |
| | CVA work is SFEP's longest-running grant program and is funded through an annual award from the California State Parks Division of Boating and Waterways (DBW). DBW as allocated more funding for the current grant cycle and would like to increase the SFEP's scope of work to include additional project elements. Executive Board approval is needed in order to accept the additional funds and execute the grant amendment. |
