Resolution Providing for Remote Meetings Pursuant to AB 361

Subject:

Adoption of Resolution No. 2021-002 Regarding Remote Meetings Pursuant to AB 361

Background:

The recently enacted bill, AB 361, provides for continuing availability of remote meetings during the pandemic-related state of emergency in California. In order to invoke this option, governing boards of Brown Act bodies, or their authorized designated committees (in this case, the Governing Board) must make certain findings in support of remote meetings within 30 days of the first meeting occurring after October 1, 2021, and every 30 days thereafter.

Attached for your review and approval is a resolution invoking AB 361 and providing for remote meetings prospectively for 30 days following the Governing Board's action.

Issues:

Findings in support of Resolution No. 2021-002 are found in the attached. Given the continuing state of public health emergency and the improved public access afforded by holding public meetings of regional bodies in a virtual setting, the resolution under AB 361 is supportable.

Recommended Action:

The Governing Board is requested to adopt Resolution No. 2021-002 authorizing the Advancing California Finance Authority, its committees, and related entities, to meet remotely pursuant to the provisions of AB 361.
