MTC Resolution Nos. 4584, Revised, 4602, Revised, and 4670. Allocation of \$12.5 million in Regional Measure 3 (RM3) capital funds to WestCAT, Solano Transportation Authority and Contra Costa Transportation Authority.

Subject:

Recommended allocations of a net total of \$12.5 million in RM3 capital funds to four projects:

- RM3 Project 26, North Bay Transit Access Improvements—\$6.7 million to WestCAT for the Zero Emission Bus and Infrastructure Project (RM3 Project #26.6) and \$3 million to Solano Transportation Authority (STA) for the SR 37/Fairgrounds Drive Interchange Improvements Project (RM3 Project #26.7)
- RM3 Project 31, I-80 Transit Improvements—\$1 million to CCTA for the San Pablo Avenue Multimodal Corridor Project (RM3 Project #31.1) and \$1.75 million to WestCAT for the Express Bus Service in I-80 Corridor Project (RM3 Project #31.2).

Background:

Bay Area voters approved Regional Measure 3 (RM3) on June 5, 2018, and on December 19, 2018, the Bay Area Toll Authority (BATA) adopted a toll schedule phasing in the resulting toll increase. BATA implemented the first and second dollars of the toll increase on January 1, 2019, and January 1, 2022, respectively.

MTC Resolution No. 4404, Revised, establishes policies and procedures to guide the delivery of capital projects funded by RM3. The overall RM3 capital expenditure program in statute is listed in Attachment A, including Commission-programmed subprojects, Letters of No Prejudice (LONPs), and allocations. Through November 2024, a total of \$1.6 billion in RM3 Capital Program allocations have been approved by the Commission and via Delegated Authority.

December RM3 Recommendations:

Staff recommends approval of \$12.5 million in RM3 allocations to four projects. The table below shows the recommended projects for this month's actions; summaries of each request are included in Attachment B, and further detail is found in each allocating resolution.

Regional Compliance:

The CCTA San Pablo Multimodal Corridor Project and STA SR 37/Fairgrounds Drive Interchange Improvements Project are subject to the requirements of the Complete Streets Policy contained in MTC Resolution 4493. CCTA and STA have submitted complete streets checklist that staff believes satisfies the Complete Streets Policy.

Additionally, as a potential fixed-guideway transit extension project, the San Pablo Multimodal Corridor Project is subject to the requirements of the Transit-Oriented Communities Policy (TOC) contained in MTC Resolution 4530, Revised. Given that the proposed allocation is for early project development, the TOC Policy requires the local jurisdiction(s) or project sponsor to submit a letter or resolution to MTC acknowledging that future allocation requests to MTC will be subject to the TOC Policy. MTC is in receipt of the attached acknowledgement letters from CCTA addressing compliance with the TOC Policy contained in MTC Resolution 4530, Revised.

Issues:


