New Position Request

- 426 full time staff (including term-limited positions)
- 4 new administrative support positions:
 - Address administrative needs for all MTC and related agency operations that have been outpaced by MTC's growing portfolio.

MTC Draft FY 2024-25 Operating Budget Amendment No. 1

Operating Revenue

- Reduced carryover amounts for Federal and State planning grants
- New Federal grants from HUD, FTA and FHWA
- Reduced REAP 2.0 grant revenue Increased Exchange Funds and RM3
- allocation

Operating Expense

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- Salary & Benefits increased for proposed new positions, offset by vacancy savings
- General Operations increased to align with 375 Beale Condo assessments
- Contractual Services increased to include grant-funded contracts and agreements

FY 2024-25 Clipper Budget

- \$1.2 million increase in Clipper 1 Capital budget to partially fund Clipper 1 contract extension
- \$6.6 million increase to Clipper 1 Operating Budget to support Clipper 1 operations and maintenance contract extension.
