Contract Amendment – Richmond-San Rafael Forward - Open Road Tolling and Interstate 580 Westbound High Occupancy Vehicle Lane Project - Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. (\$1,000,000)

Subject:

Request for approval of a contract amendment with Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. (Kimley-Horn) to add \$1,000,000 to provide Design Services During Construction for first phase of Construction.

Background:

The Richmond-San Rafael (RSR) Forward Project seeks to provide safety and operational improvements on the westbound Interstate 580 (I-580) approach to the Richmond-San Rafael Bridge by replacing the existing toll plaza and its electronic tolling with Open Road Tolling (ORT) and reinstating the previous High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) lane along westbound I-580 approaching the RSR Bridge. The HOV lane will begin at Regatta Blvd. and end at the bridge. The Project's improvements will improve transit and carpool reliability. BATA staff have completed preliminary engineering, environmental studies, project approval documents and final design of the RSR Forward Project. BATA has partnered with Caltrans to construct RSR Forward and the other ORT projects on the State-owned toll bridges using a Construction Manager/General Contractor (CMGC) contract.

Construction will be conducted in two phases to allow quicker implementation of ORT operations for the RSR Bridge. As reported at the May 2025 BATA Oversight Committee meeting, the first phase is to construct all project improvements with the current Toll System Integrator and an interim toll system structure while BATA awaits procurement of the new BATA ORT Toll System Integrator. The construction for this first phase started in November and is anticipated to be completed by the end of 2026. ORT operations are expected to start in late Summer of 2026. The second phase is to remove the interim toll system structure and install the permanent toll system when the new Toll System Integrator is under contract and completes the installation.

Contract Amendment:

In November 2019, following a competitive procurement process and a unanimous recommendation by an evaluation panel, BATA Oversight Committee approved the selection of Kimley-Horn as the prime consultant to advance the initial phase of the ORT and I-580 Westbound HOV Lane Project, including preliminary engineering, environmental studies, and project approval. The current contract value is \$6,463,000. Staff requests approval of a contract amendment with Kimley-Horn to add \$1,000,000, bringing the contract to a new total not to exceed the amount of \$7,463,000. The proposed amendment would allow Kimley-Horn to provide as needed design services during construction for the first phase of the construction. Kimley-Horn and its project team's small business enterprise status is included in Attachment A.

Recommendations:

Staff recommends that the Committee authorize the Executive Director or designee to negotiate and enter into a contract amendment with Kimley-Horn in an amount not to exceed \$1,000,000 to provide design services during construction for the first phase of construction.
