LCTOP Funding Background

State Cap and Trade/Cap and Invest Funding Program managed by Caltrans, with funding allocated to:

- Transit operators based on ridership
- MPOs based on population

FY 2025-26 Program distributed in two cycles

Cycle A

- Full year
- Final amounts known
- Due to Caltrans April 2026

Cycle B

- Half-year
- Amounts estimated, will be finalized in July/August
- Due to Caltrans Sept/Oct 2026

FY 2025-26 LCTOP Funding Distribution

North Counties/Small Operators Formula Distribution

Projects selected by operators or county transportation authorities

- **\$4.3M in Cycle A** and approx. **\$2.2M in Cycle B** funds to 16 projects:
 - Nearly 37% of funds for zero-emission vehicles and infrastructure
 - Other projects fund service expansion, free or reduced fare programs across the region
 - Over 78% of funds support projects in disadvantaged communities

Transit Performance Initiative Call for Projects

TPI Program funds cost-effective and quick to implement transit capital projects that boost speed, reliability, and rider experience

- FY 2025-26 Call for Projects initiated in late 2025
- Seven applications received
- Scoring criteria:
 - 60% Impact and cost effectiveness
 - 20% Regional and local policy support
 - 20% Readiness, capacity, and partner support

Not Recommended for funding: NVTa Operations project – not eligible;
ECCTA CAD/AVL Replacement – Avg score 28.6, better-fit funding sources available

 - Formula distribution to North Counties and Small Operators
 - Competitive Transit Performance Initiative awards under “Key Transit Corridors” category
