Contract Change Order – Express Lane Toll System Integrator (TSI): TransCore, LP (\$4,114,863)

Subject:

A request for approval to enter into a contract change order with TransCore, LP (TransCore) in an amount not to exceed \$4,114,863 to provide funds for the replacement of end-of-life hardware and software for the Express Lanes Host and Network System.

Background:

TransCore, the Express Lanes System Integrator, has since 2017 utilized software licensed from Microsoft to operate the Express Lanes Host and Network System. The Host and Network System continues to support the operation of three corridors: the Interstate 680 (I-680) Express Lanes, the Interstate 880 (I-880) Express Lanes, and the San Mateo 101 (SM-101) Express Lanes. Interstate 80 (I-80) is currently under construction and is estimated to be operational in 2025. However, the Microsoft (MS) Windows Server 2012 Operating System (OS) reached its end of life in October 2023, and the Host Database Microsoft (MS) SQL Server 2016 is set to reach its end of life in July 2026. BAIFA has secured extended support and licensing for these systems; however, replacement hardware and software must be procured and installed to ensure the toll collection system remains operational and protected from threats. Using outdated, unsupported software would increase operating costs, leave the system vulnerable to new security threats, risk disruption of the toll system, and create potential compatibility issues with peripheral systems.

A project of this size is expected to take 9 to 12 months to implement. Tasks include the procurement and installation of new hardware and software, system configuration, testing, and documentation, including a cutover plan to bring the new systems online without impacting toll operations and revenue collection.
