Timothy Haile, Executive Director This project may include a BRT component, which is a form of fixed-guideway transit subject to MTC's Transit-Oriented Communities (TOC) Policy. Consistent with the requirements of MTC's TOC Policy (MTC Resolution 4530), CCTA acknowledges that future allocations of regional discretionary funding by MTC to the San Pablo Avenue BRT Project will be subject to local land use authority compliance with the TOC Policy by the jurisdictions where BRT stations will be located. However, TOC Policy compliance is only a condition of funding if the project continues to include a BRT component.
