Bay Area Regional Energy Network (BayREN) Public Programs Update

Background:

BayREN is a collaboration of the nine counties that make up the San Francisco Bay Area. Led by ABAG, BayREN implements effective energy savings programs on a regional level and draws on the expertise, experience, and proven track record of Bay Area local governments to develop and administer successful climate, resource, and sustainability programs. BayREN is funded under the auspices of the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC). On July 3, 2023, the CPUC approved BayREN's 2024-2031 Business Plan, including the establishment of two new Public Programs (Integrated Energy Services and Targeted Decarbonization Services) focused on providing technical assistance to Bay Area local governments and special districts for their public building energy projects.
