MTC Resolution No. 4529, Revised.

Subject:

An update to the allocation of State Transit Assistance (STA) Revenue-Based Exchange Funds to shift funds from BART to AC Transit for Transit Transformation Action Plan staffing.

Background:

In September 2021, the Commission accepted the Blue Ribbon Transit Recovery Task Force's 27-point Transit Transformation Action Plan (Action Plan). The Action Plan sets a course for accelerating the Bay Area's transit network transformation integrated with recovery actions in the wake of the pandemic. The Commission committed \$85 million in near-term Blue Ribbon funding during the programming of American Rescue Plan (ARP) federal COVID-relief funds and a funding swap with transit operators and County Transportation Agencies to support implementation of the Action Plan. MTC Resolution No. 4519 establishes the funding framework for the \$85 million in Action Plan funds, focused on near-term implementation activities for Fare Coordination/Integration, Regional Mapping and Wayfinding (Customer Information), Transit Priority on Roadways, and Accessibility. MTC Resolution No. 4529 allocates the STA Revenue-Based Exchange Fund portion of Action Plan funds.

On November 15, 2023, the Commission approved approximately \$1.8 million to AC Transit and \$1.9 million to BART for staff support of Action Plan implementation. On November 19, 2025, Resolution No. 4519 was updated via Delegated Authority to program a rescission of \$152,000 from BART and program \$152,000 to AC Transit for staff support. Staff proposes to update the corresponding Resolution No. 4529 to rescind \$152,000 from BART and allocate \$152,000 to AC Transit for staff support. The overall amount of the programming and allocations for staff support line item remains the same as does the overall amount for STA Exchange funds in the Transit Transformation Action Plan.
