MTC Resolution Nos. 4519, Revised, and 4529, Revised.

Subject:

An update to the Transit Transformation Action Plan Program of Projects to program and allocate State Transit Assistance (STA) Revenue-Based Exchange Funds for Transit Transformation Action Plan staffing at AC Transit and BART.

Background:

In September 2021, the Commission received and accepted the Blue Ribbon Transit Recovery Task Force’s 27-point Transit Transformation Action Plan (Action Plan). The Action Plan sets a course for accelerating the Bay Area’s transit network transformation integrated with recovery actions in the wake of the pandemic. \$85 million in near-term Blue Ribbon funding was made available by a commitment made by the Commission during the programming of American Rescue Plan (ARP) federal COVID-relief funds and a funding swap with transit operators and County Transportation Agencies. MTC Resolution No. 4519 establishes the funding framework for the \$85 million in Action Plan funds, focused on near-term implementation activities for Fare Coordination/Integration, Regional Mapping and Wayfinding (Customer Information), and Transit Priority on Roadways. MTC Resolution No. 4529 allocates STA Revenue-Based Exchange Fund portion of Action Plan funds.

On November 15, 2023, the Commission approved approximately \$1.8 million to AC Transit and \$1.9 million to BART for staff support of Action Plan implementation. On November 19, 2025, Resolution No. 4519 was updated via Delegated Authority to program a rescission of \$152,000 from BART and program \$152,000 to AC Transit for staff support, and the corresponding update to Resolution No. 4529 was approved on March 25, 2026. This month’s proposed action would program and allocate \$310,000 to AC Transit and \$577,000 to BART for staff support for Action Plan implementation for FY 2026-2027.
