Work Plan Purpose

- The role of the Council is to provide community-grounded advice to MTC and ABAG to inform major regional decisions
- Workplan guides Council agendas through June 2027 across transportation, housing, land use, equity, and environment
- Focuses Council time on issues where community input can meaningfully influence policy outcome



Plan Bay Area 2060

- Engage on Plan Bay Area 2060, the region's integrated long-range planning process
- Provide feedback on early scenarios, equity impacts, climate adaptation, and housing-transit alignment
- Elevate community perspectives on long-term affordability and public agency financial health



Public Participation Plan



- Advise on MTC's updated Public Participation Plan and engagement practices
- Shape approaches to language access, in-person and digital outreach, and CBO partnerships
- Center engagement of communities that have historically been overlooked



Equity Priorities Communities and Affordability

- Advise on updates to the definition of Equity Priority Communities, which guide funding priorities
- Bring lived experience to inform equity methods and on-the-ground impacts
- Provide input on housing and transportation affordability, including low-income discounts across programs administered by MTC-ABAG.



Mobility Program Development

- Provide community-grounded feedback on mobility-related programs across electrification, bikeshare, active transportation, travel demand management, and traveler information
- Identify barriers and opportunities to improve affordability, safety, and ease of use based on lived experience
- Help ensure mobility investments deliver effective and equitable options across the region



Legislative Advocacy to Secure Additional Transportation, Housing and Climate Adaptation Funding for the Bay Area

- Receive updates on transit, housing, and climate funding challenges and opportunities
- Provide community-oriented input on MTC's state and federal advocacy strategies
- Help assess emerging risks and opportunities



Cross Cutting Themes

- Provide community feedback on MTC-ABAG initiatives related to climate adaptation and renewable energy/energy efficiency
- Advise on how climate risks should inform major land-use and transportation decisions
- Help prioritize investments in resilience and energy efficiency
