## Background


### **One Bay Area Grant (OBAG)**

- First adopted 2012
- Combines two federal highway formula programs:
  - Surface Transportation Block Grant Program (STP)
  - Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Improvement (CMAQ)
- Flexible funds to implement shared local and regional goals
  - Focus on Plan Bay Area

## **OBAG 4 Considerations**

- New policies/constraints
  - Transit Oriented
     Communities (TOC) Policy
  - Transit fiscal cliff (SB 125) contribution
  - Plan Bay Area 2050+
- Improve existing features
  - Sponsor requirements
  - Project selection
  - Equity considerations

**TOC Policy Compliance** 

#### **Key Features**

- Compliance tiers\* establish eligibility by jurisdiction
- Set-aside incentive for top tier

\*Requirements under development, to be informed by ongoing partner outreach

Non-Compliant Jurisdictions	Substantially Compliant Jurisdictions	<b>Compliant</b> Jurisdictions	Non-TOC Jurisdictions	
Eligible for limited planning funds	Eligible for most funding	Eligible for all funding, including <b>set-aside</b>	Eligible for most funding
