MTC Resolution No. 4586, Revised. Allocation of \$7 million in Regional Measure 3 (RM3) capital funds to Contra Costa Transportation Authority (CCTA) for Interstate 680/State Route 4 Interchange Improvements.

Subject:

Recommended allocation of \$7 million in RM3 capital funds to RM3 Project 19, Contra Costa I-680/SR-4 Interchange Improvements—\$7 million to CCTA for the I-680/SR-4 Interchange Improvements Phase 1, 2A, and 4 Project (RM3 Project #19.1).

Background:

Bay Area voters approved Regional Measure 3 (RM3) on June 5, 2018, and on December 19, 2018, the Bay Area Toll Authority (BATA) adopted a toll schedule phasing in the resulting toll increase. As of January 1, 2025, BATA has implemented the full three-dollar RM3 toll.

MTC Resolution No. 4404, Revised, establishes policies and procedures to guide the delivery of capital projects funded by RM3. The overall RM3 capital expenditure program in statute is listed in Attachment A, including Commission-programmed subprojects, Letters of No Prejudice (LONPs), and allocations. Through March 2025, a total of \$1.63 billion in RM3 Capital Program allocations have been approved by the Commission and via Delegated Authority.

April RM3 Recommendations:

Staff recommends approval of an RM3 allocation of \$7 million to the I-680/SR-4 Interchange Improvements Phase 1, 2A, and 4 Project, as noted in the table below. A summary of this request is included in Attachment B, and further detail is found in the allocating resolution.
