Brief Scope of Work:	Consultant will lead data collection and analysis to identify and prioritize restoration projects and guide technical report writing to generate a revised watershed-scale restoration action plan, as well as lead design services to create 100% designs for critical trail gaps between the underserved community of North Richmond and the Bay Trail and complete a feasibility study and alternatives analysis for a secondary trail gap along Wildcat Creek Watershed.
