# Why do we develop an Overall Work Program (OWP)?



**Statutorily-required process** for metropolitan planning organizations (MPOs) leveraging federal and state transportation planning funds

**Opportunity to coordinate with federal & state partners** including Caltrans, FHWA, and FTA – as well as local partners

**Synced with next fiscal year's budget** and work planning process across the broader organization

# What's in the OWP?

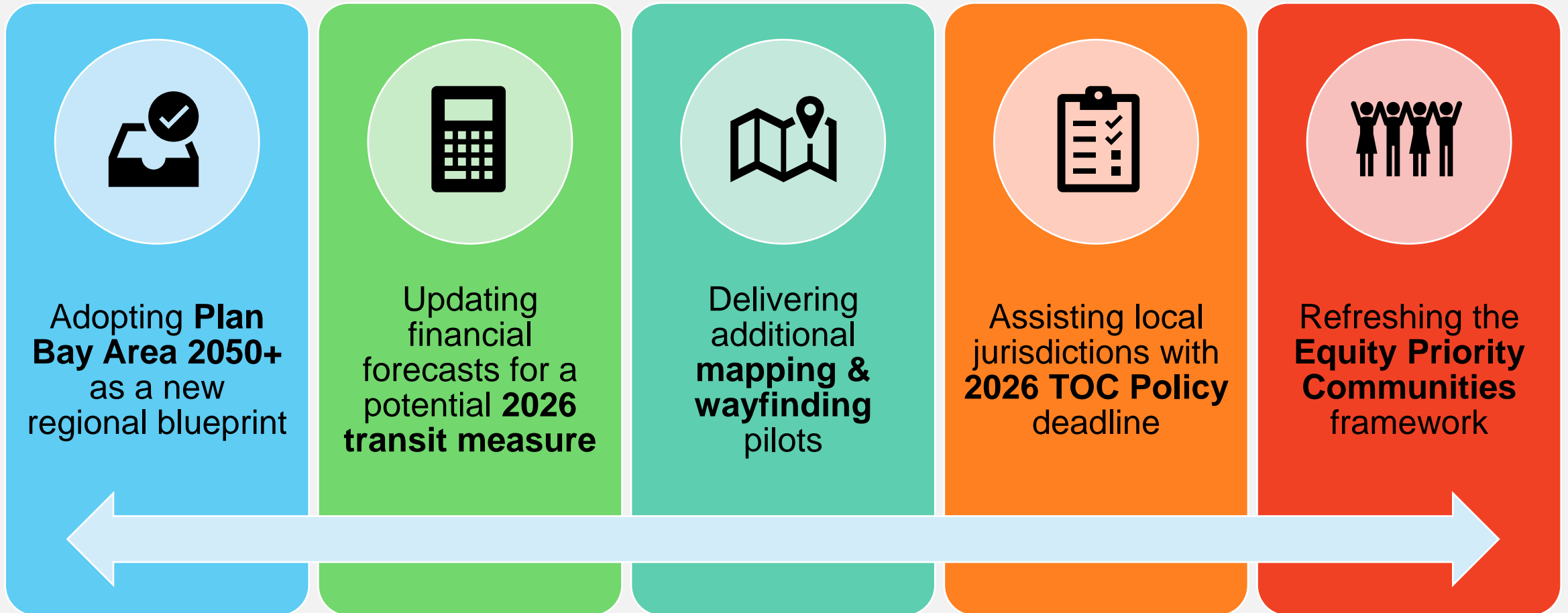
## What's included?

- Scope and budget for projects and programs funded by federal & state transportation planning monies, for both MTC and Caltrans District 4
- Demonstrates alignment with federal planning requirements, including planning factors, public participation & coordination, and certification recommendations

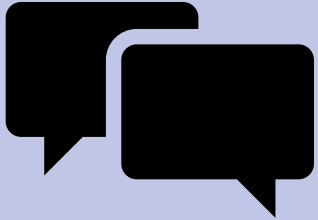
## What's not included?

- Other transportation-related activities not funded by federal & state planning monies, including efforts led by BATA and BAIFA (*reflected in MTC Budget*)
- Initiatives led by ABAG, including but not limited to BayREN and SFEP (*reflected in ABAG Budget*)

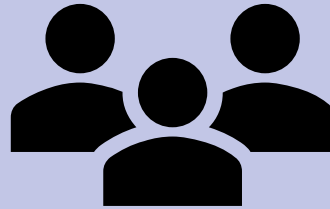
