Consultant Bench: 2025 Quick Build Design and Engineering Services - Cycle 1

**Subject:** 

This memorandum requests approval of a pre-qualified bench of consultants summarized on Attachment A ("Bench") to provide as-needed consulting assistance services to support MTC with quick-build design and engineering services. The term of the Bench is from July 1, 2025 to June 30, 2028, with an option to extend for an additional two years to June 30, 2030. Other public entities will be eligible to utilize firms on the bench for their own quick-build design and

engineering services.

**Background:** 

On March 12, 2025, MTC issued a Request for Qualifications for the 2025 Quick-Build Design, and Engineering Services Bench, Cycle 1 ("RFQ") inviting firms to submit Statements of Qualifications ("SOQ") for Design and Engineering Services.

An email notice of the opportunity was sent to 6,434 individuals and firms. On March 26, 2025 MTC received 18 SOQs from firms. The Minimum Qualifications required that teams must include at least one key person who is either a California licensed professional Civil Engineer, Architect, or Landscape Architect. All SOQs were determined to meet the Minimum Qualifications. An evaluation panel comprised of MTC staff reviewed applicants based upon the following evaluation criteria specified in the RFQ, which are listed in descending order of importance:

- 1. Quick-Build Experience 40%
- 2. Key Personnel Experience 30%
- 3. Previous Augmented/On-Call Staff Experience 20%
- 4. Presentation 10%

Possible Total: 100%

The firms that the evaluation panels recommend for inclusion on the Bench are indicated with a number "1" in Attachment A. All 18 firms demonstrated expertise in Quick-Build Design and Engineering services and thus were recommended for the Bench. The recommended firms

provide a mix of local and national experience and expertise that will be valuable in helping local agencies design a broad range of quick-build projects in the Bay Area.

A summary of each firm's Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) status and Small Business Enterprise (SBE) status is listed by service category on Attachment B. Four (4) of the firms who applied to the Bench are DBE and SBE firms. Each of these 18 firms willserve as Prime Consultants if selected for a contract.

Any firms approved in Cycle 1 will be eligible for work throughout the life of the Bench. Selection for entry into a contract with one of the pre-qualified consultants may take place by direct selection or via a mini-procurement, pursuant to MTC's Third-Party Contracting Policies and Procedures. Additional firms may be added to the Bench in response to re-issuance of the RFQ in later cycles given certain conditions.

Contract periods of performance and amounts will be determined on a per-contract basis based on the project solicited to the Bench. The amount included for this program in the proposed FY 2025-26 budgets will be determined on a per-contract and project basis. Staff will return to the Administration Committee for authorization of any contracts exceeding the Executive Director's signature authority.

MTC established a similar bench in February 2021 that expires on June 30, 2025. The Consultant Bench: 2020 Quick-Build Design and Engineering and Construction Management Services – Cycle 1, was approved by the Operations Committee on February 12, 2021.

#### **Issues:**

None identified.

#### **Recommendations:**

Staff recommends that the Committee approve the pre-qualified consultant bench identified in Attachment A to provide Quick-Build Design and Engineering services to MTC on an as-needed basis, for a period through July 30, 2028, with an option to extend the Bench performance period through June 30, 2030.
