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BAHFA's New Strategic Plan

- Repositions BAHFA for success after expiration of one-time funds and Regional Measure 4 setback
- Fiscally prudent plan with focus on leveraging regional scale to add value
- Charts a path to financial self-sufficiency by 2030
- Reaffirms long-term vision for BAHFA:
 - Win transformative resources
 - Work together to achieve impact at scale

Programs & Near-Term Goals

Doorway Housing Portal

- Sustain program with largest reach
- Grow market share & increase listings (ADUs, etc.)
- Create efficiencies via economies of scale
- Transition to revenue neutral by 2030

Mixed-Income Financing Program

- Deliver affordability with limited public subsidy
- Support innovative mixed-income models
- Leverage private capital
- Pilot revenue-positive public lender model

Revenue Measure & Regional Coordination

- Identify changes needed to enabling statute and build coalition to support
- Explore regional measure, as early as 2028
- Support local implementation of state housing laws

Investing in BAHFA's Future

- BAHFA is seeking a **\$15 million** investment from state budget
- **One-time** request
- **Matched** by Philanthropy & MTC
- **Bridge to self-sufficiency** by 2030
- **Request is made in partnership** with Los Angeles and San Diego housing agencies for a total \$32M ask.
