

Overview

- The Transit Capital Priorities Program (TCP) programs nearly \$700 million annually in FTA federal formula funds to the region, guided by federal requirements and MTC's TCP Policy
 - 5307 Urbanized Area Formula Grants, approx. \$331 M / year
 - 5337 State of Good Repair Grants, approx. \$337 M / year
 - 5339 Grants for Buses and Bus Facilities, approx. \$16 M / year
- Today's item programs \$1.5 B over two years, through the end of the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL)



FYs 2025 & 2026 Programming (in \$M)



Bus Replacements



- 408 bus replacements, \$429 M
- Of 408 bus replacements in the program, 278 will be zeroemission (68%), \$336 M (78% of total bus purchase funds)
- New Bus/Van Pricelist in place, challenge to meet all needs

Railcar Replacements

- \$125 M for Caltrain electric multiple unit (EMU) cars
- \$117 M for SFMTA Light Rail Vehicles
- \$96 M for BART Replacement Railcars – pay-go and debt service



Infrastructure: Fixed Guideway & ZEB

- \$359 M in Fixed Guideway State of Good Repair programming
 - Train Control
 - Track Maintenance and Rail Replacement
 - Ferry Fixed Guideway Connectors
- \$67 M in Preventive Maintenance
- \$22 M in ZEB infrastructure projects
