Contract Amendment – Public Engagement Support: Kearns & West, Inc. (\$125,000)

Subject:

Authorization to negotiate and to enter into a contract amendment in an amount not to exceed \$125,000 with Kearns & West, Inc. to provide public engagement support for major MTC initiatives, including Plan Bay Area 2050+ and the MTC Public Participation Plan, for a new contract not to exceed the amount of \$525,000.

Background:

The Plan Bay Area engagement program is a massive, multi-year effort that includes general public engagement, as well as outreach to youth, community-based organizations, Tribal governments, local jurisdiction staff, agency partners and many other stakeholders. MTC staff requires the support of an experienced firm with expert public engagement and planning professionals to be able to execute and deliver the myriads of public engagement activities for Plan Bay Area and related projects, including the MTC Public Participation Plan.

Contract Overview:

In October 2021, MTC issued a Request for Qualifications (RFQ) to establish an on-call bench of pre-qualified firms to provide services for Public Engagement, Digital Engagement and Promotion, and Market Research support. The RFQ included three service categories including 1) public engagement, 2) digital engagement and promotion, and 3) market research expertise. In December 2021, this Committee approved thirteen firms for placement on an on-call bench through December 31, 2024, with an option to extend for an additional two years to December 31, 2026. The on-call bench included Kearns & West, Inc., which qualified in the public engagement category.

In June 2023, MTC entered into a contract with Kearns & West, Inc. for public engagement support to plan and execute public engagement activities related to Plan Bay Area 2050+. Under this contract, Kearns & West, Inc. supported implementation of Rounds 1, 2 and 3 of Plan Bay Area 2050+ engagement. In addition to this work, Kearns & West, Inc. also supported implementation of Transit 2050+ and transportation revenue measure engagement.

Next Steps:

The proposed contract amendment with Kearns & West, Inc. would focus on updating the MTC Public Participation Plan and the Plan Bay Area 2050+ engagement evaluation. MTC staff will work with Kearns & West, Inc. to develop and implement the engagement strategy for revising the MTC Public Participation Plan and other engagement-related efforts.

Kearns & West, Inc. is a certified Small Business Enterprise (SBE) and has no subcontractors.

Recommendations:

Staff recommends that the Committee authorize the Executive Director or designee to negotiate and enter into a contract amendment with Kearns & West, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$125,000 for a new contract not to exceed the amount of \$525,000 for the work described above.
