Contract Change Order– FasTrak® Regional Customer Service Center Support of the Open Road Tolling Program: Conduent State and Local Solutions, Inc. (\$200,000)

Subject:

A request for Committee approval to enter into a contract change order with Conduent State and Local Solutions, Inc. (Conduent) to support the Open Road Tolling Program in an amount not to exceed \$200,000, subject to the approval of the FY 2023-24 BATA budget.

Background:

Based on a competitive selection, BATA entered into a contract with Conduent (formerly, Xerox State and Local Solutions, Inc.) on March 27, 2013 for the management and operation of the FasTrak[®] Customer Service Center (CSC). Under the contract, Conduent provides the FasTrak[®] account management system, transaction processing, call center operations, web services, payment processing, customer communications, violation image review and violation noticing for bridges and express lanes in the Bay Area.

BATA is in the process of replacing its existing toll system at the seven State-owned bridges in the Bay Area as part of its conversion to Open Road Tolling (ORT). The conversion at each bridge involves the replacement of roadside equipment which generates, records, and transmits transactional data to the CSC for account posting and reconciliation. The Scope of Work for this item covers Conduent participation in workshops and meetings with BATA and ORT Toll System Integrator staff during the system design phase along with providing input and feedback into design documents relevant to data exchange and the review of proposed test plans and scripts. The work shall be performed on a Time and Materials basis.

Attachment A includes a summary of Conduent and its project team's small business and disadvantaged business enterprise status.

Staff recommends that the Committee authorize the Executive Director or designee to negotiate and enter into a contract change order with Conduent to support the Open Road Tolling Program in an amount not to exceed \$200,000, subject to the approval of the FY 2023-24 BATA budget.
