Work Project Title:	BayREN Existing Building Study
Purpose of Project:	To collect information about existing buildings in order to facilitate the ability of local governments to develop effective policies related to the energy use and decarbonization of existing buildings, including reaching climate goals
Brief Scope of Work:	Collect, analyze and collate data on the existing building stock in the Bay Area, and develop detailed information and decarbonization pathways for a subset of building types, in order to provide information both for the region as a whole and for each jurisdiction
Project Cost Not to Exceed:	\$594,499
Funding Source:	PG&E (ratepayer funds) as directed by the CPUC
Fiscal Impact:	Funds programmed in FY 23-24 Budget
Motion by Committee:	The Executive Board is requested to authorize the Executive Director of the Metropolitan Transportation Commission, or his designee, on behalf of the Association of Bay Area Governments and the Bay Area Regional Energy Network, to negotiate and enter into contract with Arup US, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$594,499 for the Bay Area Existing Building Study for the period from December 1, 2023 to December 31, 2024.
