Purpose of Project:	Watershed-scale planning and implementation in the North Richmond/Wildcat Creek watershed
Brief Scope of Work:	Create a watershed-scale restoration action plan, implement critically needed restoration in the lower part of the watershed, and create design plans to address gaps in the Wildcat Creek Trail
Project Cost Not to Exceed:	\$6,102,000
Funding Source:	US EPA San Francisco Bay Water Quality Improvement Fund
Fiscal Impact:	Funds programmed in FY24-25
Motion by Committee:	The Executive Board is requested to authorize the Executive Director of the Metropolitan Transportation Commission, or his designee, to accept an award from and enter into a funding agreement with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency on behalf of the Association of Bay Area Governments and the San Francisco Estuary Partnership to receive \$6,102,000 to undertake watershed-scale planning and implementation in the North Richmond/Wildcat Creek Watershed, and to negotiate and enter into subaward agreements with: Contra Costa County Flood Control and Water Conservation District in an amount not to exceed \$2,500,000; The Watershed Project in amount not to exceed \$450,000; and Urban Tilth in an amount not to exceed \$150,000.
