<b>Funder:</b>	US Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA)
<b>Work Project Title:</b>	Wildcat Creek Restoration
<b>Purpose of Project:</b>	Watershed-scale planning and implementation in the North Richmond/Wildcat Creek watershed
<b>Brief Scope of Work:</b>	Create a watershed-scale restoration action plan, implement critically needed restoration in the lower part of the watershed, and create design plans to address gaps in the Wildcat Creek Trail
<b>Project Cost Not to Exceed:</b>	\$6,102,000
<b>Funding Source:</b>	US EPA San Francisco Bay Water Quality Improvement Fund
<b>Fiscal Impact:</b>	Funds programmed in FY24-25
<b>Motion by Committee:</b>	The Executive Board is requested to authorize the Executive Director of the Metropolitan Transportation Commission, or his designee, to accept an award from and enter into a funding agreement with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency on behalf of the Association of Bay Area Governments and the San Francisco Estuary Partnership to receive \$6,102,000 to undertake watershed-scale planning and implementation in the North Richmond/Wildcat Creek Watershed, and to negotiate and enter into subaward agreements with: Contra Costa County Flood Control and Water Conservation District in an amount not to exceed \$2,500,000; The Watershed Project in amount not to exceed \$450,000; and Urban Tilth in an amount not to exceed \$150,000.
